Banfi Chianti Classico embodies all the characteristics that have made this wine an enduring classic: an alluring bouquet of black fruit and violets; rich flavors of cherry and leather; supple tannins and good acidity for dining.

Chianti is produced in eight adjacent, yet distinct, areas that cover a vast part of central Tuscany. But only one, which is the oldest and original, may produce Chianti Classico. However, provenance alone is not sufficient to merit the designation Chianti Classico with the balzon of the black rooster. The producer must strictly adhere to all DOCG (Guarantee of origin and quality) rules, which cover elements of vinification (such as alcohol content, yield per acre, and blend) as well as aging and bottling.

Varietal: Cabernet Sauvignon, Canaiolo Nero, Sangiovese

Vintage: 2016

Region: Italy, Tuscany

Color: Ruby-red.

Bouquet: Intense with notes of cherries, plums, and violets.

Taste: Rich flavors of cherry and leather. Supple tannins and good acidity.

Food Pairing: Perfect accompaniment to a wide variety of foods, including red-sauced pastas, grilled meats and roasts.
